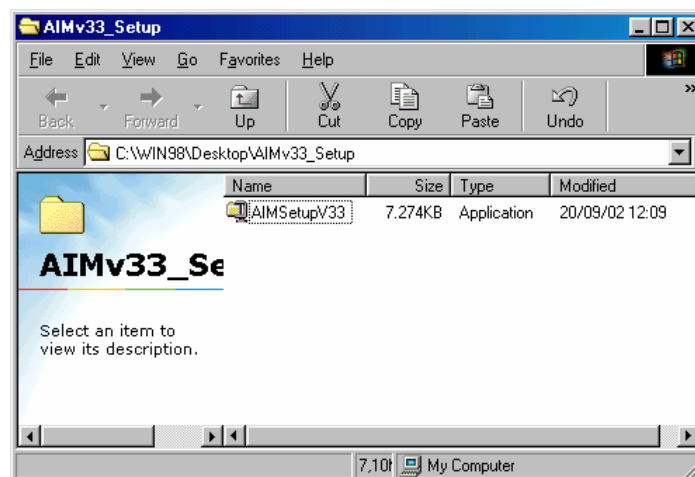

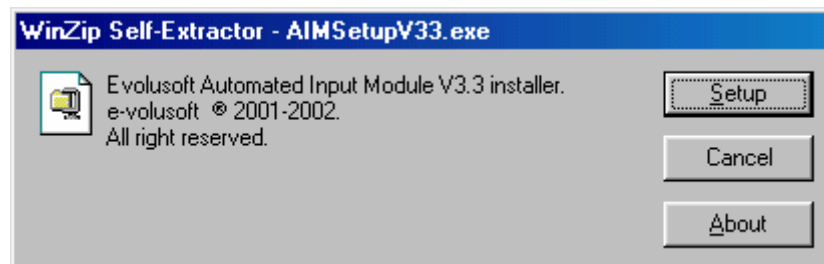
## Installing Automated Input Module V3.3

### Step 1:

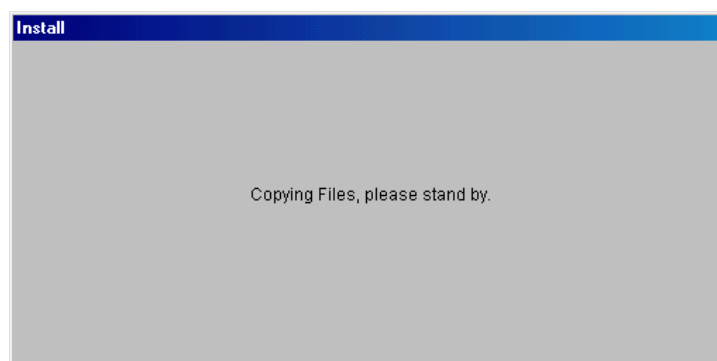
Look for the file **aimsetupv33.exe**; it is a self-extractable file. It must be on the client computer.



When the set up starts please make sure that the version you are installing is 3.3. Then click on the SETUP button to continue.



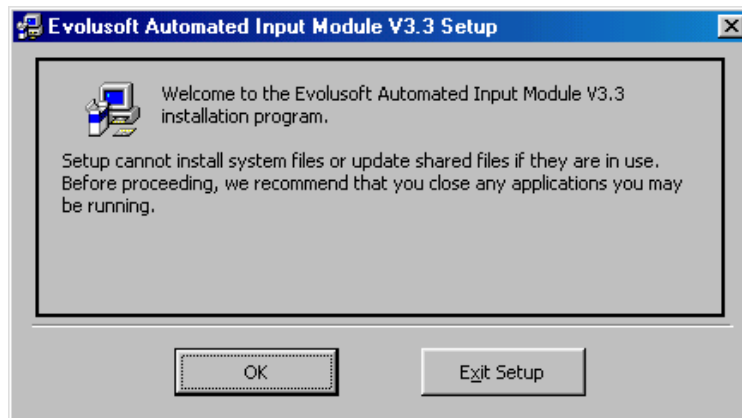
The setup program will check if you have all necessary files, if not it will install all of them for you.





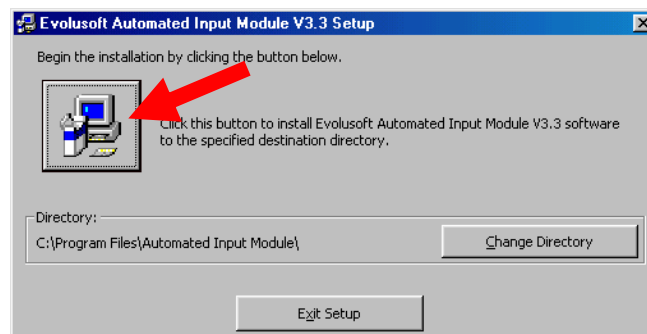
## Step 2:

After installing necessary files it will check for the files that are in use. Please close any applications you may be running. Click on the OK button to continue.



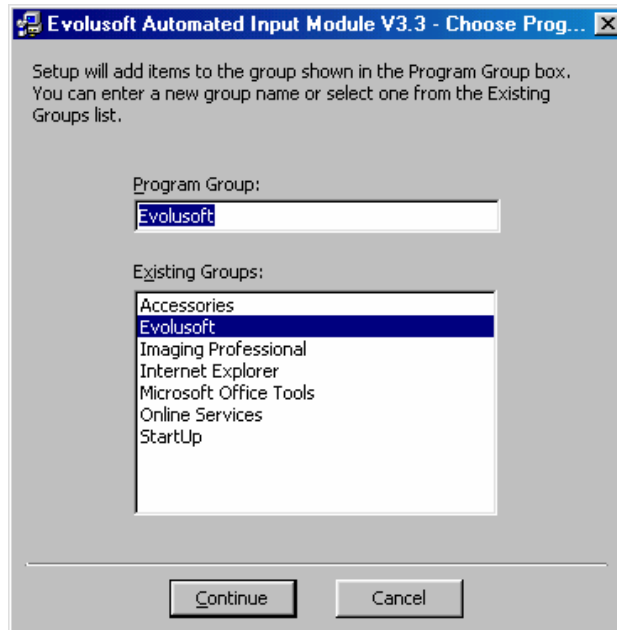
## Step 3:

On this window you will be able to change the installation path. We recommend that you accept the default value. Please click on the computer ICON button to continue.



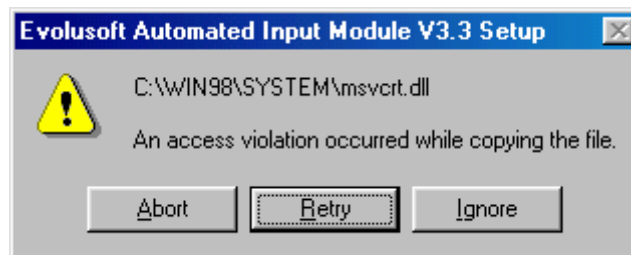
### Step 4:

On this window you will be able to create a Program Group by changing the default name on the Program Group field. However you also can choose an existing program group from the list. We recommend you to accept the default value by clicking on the CONTINUE button.



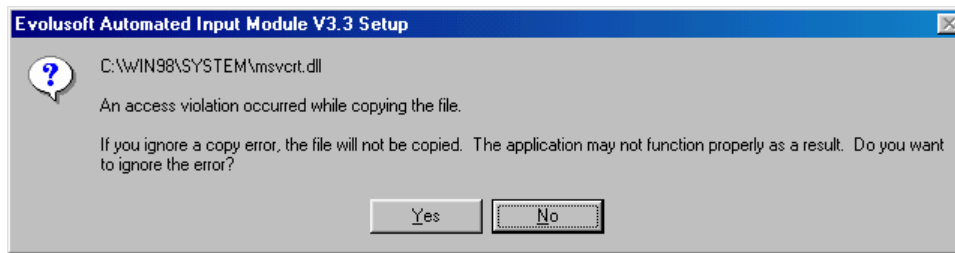
### Step 5:

On the phase the setup program will start copying all application files. If you get the following warning message:



Please click on the IGNORE button, since it is a file that already exists on your system. This message will show up in some computer.

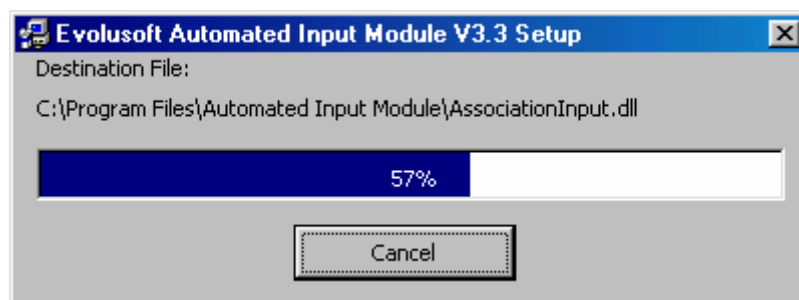
After you click on the IGNORE button, you must confirm that you want to ignore this file operation. Just click on the YES button to confirm.



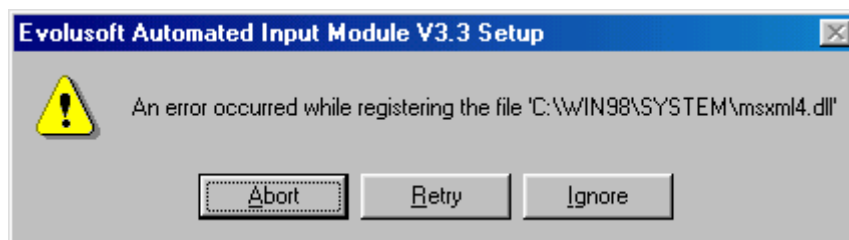
Depending of the operating system will get these messages with one or two files.

### Step 6:

The setup program will start copying all application files.



When it reaches to the phase of registering components and activex controls you probably will get this warning message. Please click on the ignore button. Again depending of the operating system you will get this message.

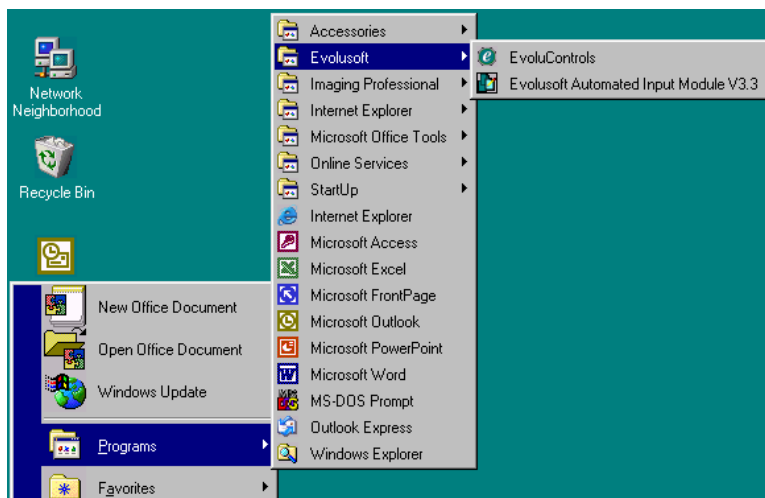


Once the setup program finished to copying all files you will get the confirmation message.



**STEP 7:**

In order to start the Automated Input Module, please click on the start button, choose program, look for the program group "Evolusoft" then choose "Automated Input Module".



# Uninstalling Automated Input Module v3.3

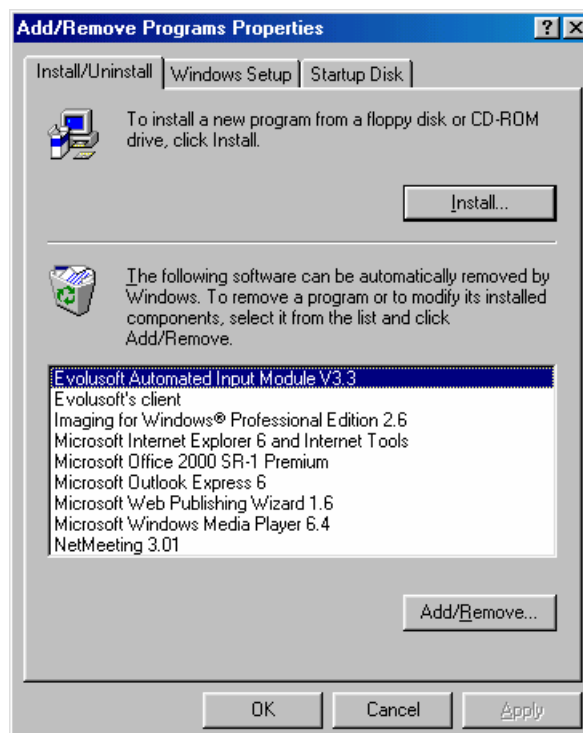
## STEP 1:

In order to uninstall the Automated Input Module we must go to the control panel by clicking on the START button, choose SETTINGS, then CONTROL PANEL.



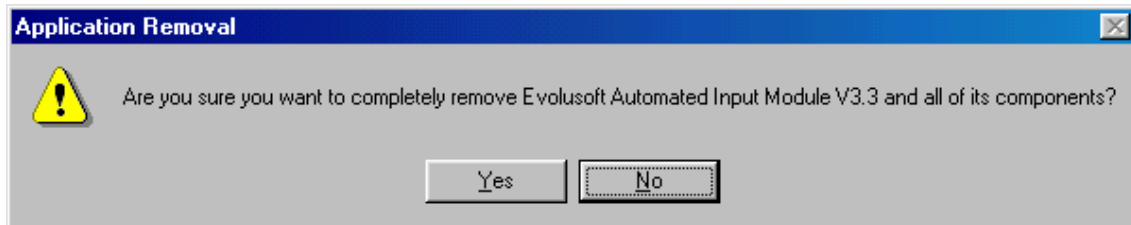
## STEP 2:

Click on the "Add/Remove" icon. Look on the installed application list for the Evolusoft Automated Input Module V3.3.



### STEP 3:

Select the Automated Input Module V.3.3. Click on the ADD/Remove button then confirm that it is the application that you want to remove.



The uninstall program will be loaded, removing all the application files from your system. After it finished, it will show the following message. Click on the OK button to exit the uninstall program.

We recommend that you restart your system.
